Objective:

Have students understand the uniqueness of their identity

Big Idea:

School is an opportunity to discover your talents

1. Warm Up / Anticipatory 20 min

School is your "drawing board" to help you discover your talents=skills=gifts. Libraries help you in this role of self-discovery.

2. Investigation and New Learning 15 min

[Share a book display featuring talented "famous" people](#) - have students discuss the the skills that these individuals needed to develop and recognize their talents.

Pablo Picasso is quoted as saying: *"The meaning of life is to find your gift. The purpose of life is to give it away."*

What gift/talent did Pablo Picasso give away?

Hand out the display books to students in groups of two or three. Have each group give a mini-report on the featured biographies and have them guess which skills were important for each person to develop while in school.
